PPA is a regionalized funding program of the PCA. A total of 16 local organizations administer PPA and serve all 67 counties in Pennsylvania by re-granting funds to support a wide variety of local and community arts activities.

PPA Project Stream grants are available to support arts activities that take place between September 1, 2010 and August 31, 2011. Grant requests may not exceed \$3,000. Applications are due postmarked on or before June 18, 2009.
