The lectures and workshop are free to Pocono chapter PA Guild of Craftsmen members and the East Stroudsburg University community. For all others, there is a charge of \$10 per lecture and \$50 for the small workshop.

Pocono Chapter members and East Stroudsburg University students/faculty will have priority selection for this workshop. If there are openings available, a random drawing will be held. Up to 20 observers can be accommodated in addition to the presenters.
